TRACK&KNOW VISION AND OBJECTIVES

PROJECT ETHICS, DATA REQUIREMENTS & GOVERNANCE: PREPARATION FOR D9.2 & D9.1

Discussion and agreement on broader ethical issues followed by specific discussions for data handling in light of GDPR. Handling here refers to: anonymization; types of analysis; data convolution etc. Including actions to be taken in the event of inadvertent breaches.
